HM M/S 20 30/11/2020 Pindah 100,000 kerapu hibrid ke kolam khas

Permaisuri: Seramai 30 penternak ikan kerapu hibrid di Laguna Setiu. Kampung Gong Batu di sini, memindahkan lebih 100,000 ikan ke kolam tangki khas bagi mengelakkan mereka berputih mata pada musim tengkujuh.

Wakil penternak, Johari Awang Besar berkata, langkah itu dilakukan susulan tahap kemasinan air di muara sungai turun mendadak hingga bacaan air berubah hampir menjadi tawar sepenuhnya akibat limpahan air hujan dari Sungai Setiu.

"Jika tidak sebarang tindakan segera, sudah pasti pengusaha berdepan kerugian hampir RM500,000 seperti dialami beberapa pengusaha ketika musim tengkujuh tahun lalu.

"Kerja memindahkan ikan bermula sejak Khamis lalu dan berterusan hingga ke hari ini (semalam) memandangkan bacaan air masin masih menurun," katanya.

Tinjauan mendapati semua ikan berkenaan dipindahkan ke kolam tangki berbumbung dan kolam terbuka di beberapa lokasi sekitar Kampung Gong Batu dan Kampung Fikri serta ditempatkan di situ selama dua

minggu sebelum dibawa semula ke sangkar apabila bacaan air kembali seperti sedia kala.

Hanya kerapu hibrid dipindahkan ke situ manakala

ikan siakap masih di dalam sangkar kerana ia mempunyai ketahanan terhadap air tawar.

"Ikan yang dipindahkan terdiri daripada pelbagai saiz dengan berat

300 gram hingga melebihi sekilogram seekor. Rata-rata pengusaha mengupah pekerja melakukan pemindahan dan menanggung kos tinggi termasuk sewa lori," katanya.

Sementara itu, inisiatif berbeza dilaksanakan pengusaha di Kampung Keluang, Besut apabila mereka menjual lebih awal ikan ternakan bagi mengelak menanggung kerugian.

Penternak dan pemborong ikan, Ismail Ab Rahman berkata, 200,000 anak ikan siakap berukuran 1.27 hingga 6.35 sentimeter (sm) dibeli daripada tujuh pengusaha di situ.

"Sepatutnya benih itu berukuran 10sm ke atas baru boleh dijual, tetapi bagi mengelak pengusaha menanggung kerugian jika kolam ditenggelami air hujan, mereka menjualnya lebih awal.

"Di sini (Kampung Keluang) adalah pusat asuhan benih siakap yang diternak sebaik telur menetas dan dijual hingga mencapai ukuran tertentu," katanya.

Menurut Ismail, benih ikan dibelinya itu akan dipindahkan ke kolam tangki berbumbung yang disewa khas.

Purple hulls required for Melaka fishing vessels by 2022

ALOR GAJAH: Registered fishing vessels in Melaka are required to be painted purple by 2022.

The colour scheme was also chosen to differentiate Melaka fishing boats from other states, in addition to facilitating law enforcement by the state Fisheries Department.

Its director, Mohd Fauzi Solehon, said fishermen in the state were urged to adopt the colour scheme from now onwards to ensure that it could be standardised by 2022.

"The colour of boats for Melaka has been designated purple as each state has its own colour scheme, making it easier for a boat to be identified.

"It (purple colour scheme) also makes it easier for the authorities to carry out enforcement and monitoring at sea and also preserve fishery resources," he said here yesterday.

Apart from that, purple was chosen because the boat's hull would be seen as less dirty compared with bright colours such as white and yellow, he said.

Asyraf Ibrahim, 26, helped paint the fibre-glass boat belonging to his father Ibrahim Md Isa, 66, at the fishing base in Kampung Balik Batu, near here, to comply with the new rule.

He said despite having to incur the cost of buying paint, his father complied with the rule to ensure that no legal action would be taken.

Fazli Baba, 34, had requested for his new fibre-glass boat which he ordered two months ago to be painted purple.

"I have been using the new RM11,000 purple boat since last month.

"Most of the other fishermen had also resorted to painting their vessels with the same colour scheme.

"Previously, there was no specific colour set for boats in the state (Melaka).

"However, the boat licence renewal notice issued by the Fisheries Department stated that fishermen are now required to paint their boat purple," he said at Kampung Pasir Gembor.

He added that a purple-hulled boat was also easier to detect in the middle of the sea, including during rain.
